Field trip money requests were starting to come in. There was a donation to the Glenbard South Scholarship. Year-to-date \$71,717 revenue, and \$39,000 in expenses, net \$32,000 and more expenses coming through. All receipts and expenses were to have been submitted by the end of May. There was nothing to report from the presidents.

The principal report shared staffing news for administrative assistant, new nurse, and a teacher retirement. There was a playground update on multiple options that can cost around \$90,000. The Student Council was leading an end of school year countdown. Thanks went to volunteers of Field Day, the teachers who ran Art and Drama Club and patience with using the new school check-in system. A reminder to register for the 2025-2026 school year. The teacher representative thanked volunteers for Teacher Appreciation Week.

Fifth Grade Fling was discussed. An update on the plant sale was given. Volunteers were thanked for their support. Bulldog Run was canceled due to low enrollment and will discuss how to move forward next school year. Budget Meeting for the 2025-2026 school year will take place in the fall. Gratitude was given to Billy Cruz for his leadership as Co-President and Amber Norman for being treasurer.
